BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS

- 1. Draw diagonal lines on the wrong side of (24) **D 3**" squares.
- Place (1) D 3" square right sides together on one end of E 3" X 5-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line, then trim excess to 1/4" and press open. Repeat on other side to complete DE UNIT, square to 3" X 5-1/2", make (12).
- 3. Sew (1) **DE UNIT** to each side of **A** 5-1/2" square. Sew (1) **E** 3" square to each end of (2) **DE UNITs**, then sew to top and bottom to complete **BLOCK 1**. Square to 10-1/2", make (3).
- 4. Draw diagonal lines on the wrong side of (12) E 2-1/2" squares.
- 5. Place (1) E 2-1/2" square right sides together on one corner of B 5-1/2" square. Sew on drawn line, then trim excess to 1/4" and press open. Repeat on opposite corner to complete BLOCK 2. Square to 5-1/2", make (6).

RUNNER ASSEMBLY: Refer to **QUILT DIAGRAM** for proper placement and rotation.

- 6. Sew (2) **BLOCK 2s** together, then sew together with (1) **BLOCK 1** and (1) **F** 1-1/2" X 10-1/2" strip to create **BLOCK ROWS**.
- 7. Sew **BLOCK ROWS** together with (2) **F** 1-1/2" X 16-1/2" strips.




















BLOCK 1 make (3)





BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements. Refer to **QUILT DIAGRAM** for proper placement and rotation.

- 8. Sew (1) \mathbf{F} 1-1/2" \mathbf{X} (32-1/2") strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) \mathbf{F} 1-1/2" \mathbf{X} (18-1/2") strip to top and bottom of quilt.
- 9. Sew (1) C 2-1/2" X (34-1/2") strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) C 2-1/2" X (22-1/2") strip to top and bottom of quilt.

FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with **F** fabric.
