## MATERIALS:

7/8 yard Iconic Iowa Red  
1 yard Blender Poppy  
7/8 yard Landmarks Blue  
2-1/2 yards Blender Navy, **includes binding**  
1-1/2 yards Blender Almond  
1-1/8 yards Blender Parchment  
5-1/2 yards (40" WOF) or 2-3/8 yards  
(108" WOF) fabric of choice, Backing  
86" x 86" Batting

## RECOMMENDED TOOLS:

Creative Grids, The Big Easy 12-1/2" x 24-1/2"  
Creative Grids 4-1/2" Square Ruler

*READ THROUGH ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING. SEW PIECES RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER AND USE A 1/4" SEAM ALLOWANCE THROUGHOUT UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED. WOF - WIDTH OF FABRIC; RST - RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER; HST - HALF SQUARE TRIANGLES*

## CUTTING:

### From Blender Almond Fabric:

Cut [9] — 4-1/2" x WOF strip  
Subcut [66] — 4-1/2" squares, Unit A  
Cut [1] — 7" x WOF strip  
Subcut [3] — 7" squares, cut twice diagonally, yielding [12] triangles, Unit G

### From Blender Parchment Fabric:

Cut [3] — 4-1/2" x WOF strip  
Subcut [24] — 4-1/2" squares, Unit B  
Cut [2] — 7" x WOF strips  
Subcut [6] — 7" squares, cut twice diagonally, yielding [24] triangles, Unit H

### From Blender Poppy Fabric:

Cut [6] — 4-1/2" x WOF strips  
Subcut [46] — 4-1/2" squares, Unit D  
Cut [1] — 7" x WOF strip  
Subcut [1] — 7" square, cut twice diagonally, yielding [4] triangles, Unit J

### From Iconic Iowa Fabric:

Cut [6] — 4-1/2" x WOF strips  
Subcut [48] — 4-1/2" squares, Unit C

### From Landmarks Blue Fabric:

Cut [6] — 4-1/2" x WOF strips  
Subcut [42] — 4-1/2" squares, Unit E

### From Blender Navy Fabric:

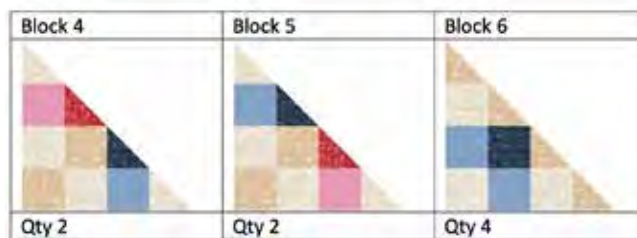
Cut [5] — 4-1/2" x WOF strips  
Subcut [38] — 4-1/2" squares, Unit F  
Cut [1] — 7" x WOF strip  
Subcut [2] — 7" squares, cut twice diagonally to make [8] triangles  
Cut [8] — 4-1/4" x WOF strips, Border  
Cut [8] — 2-1/2" x WOF strips, Binding

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

### Block Fabric Key:

Background Light - Blender Almond  
Background Dark - Blender Parchment  
Light Red - Iconic Iowa  
Dark Red - Blender Poppy  
Light Blue - Landmarks Blue  
Dark Blue - Blender Navy

1. Arrange units according to the diagrams.
2. Sew neighboring units together. Press.
3. Sew neighboring rows together matching seams. Press.
4. Create block quantities listed.



## QUILT ASSEMBLY:

The Glory Quilt is created on-point. This layout creates a dramatic effect with simple sewing.

1. Layout the blocks as shown below. Notice the rows are not created horizontally but rather at a slant or diagonally.

Row #1: Block 7

Row #2: Block 6 - 1 - 5

Row #3: Block 6 - 1 - 2 - 3 - 4

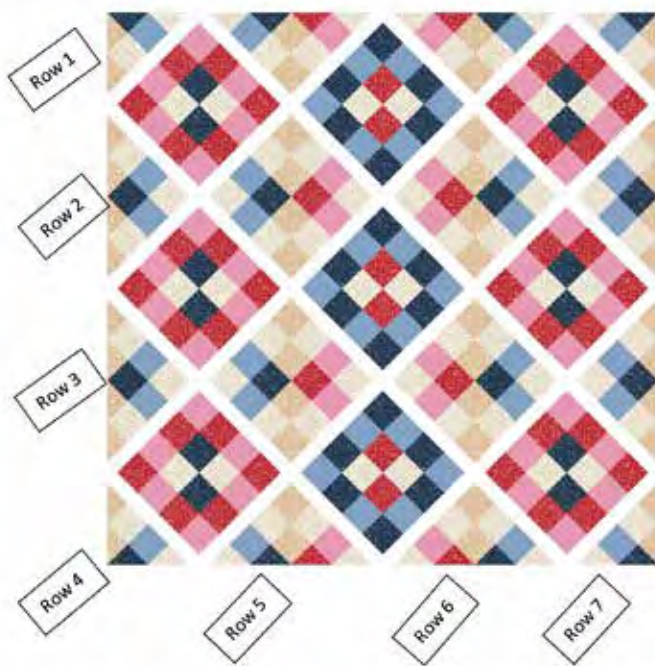
Row #4: Block 8 - 1 - 2 - 3 - 2 - 1 - 8

Row #5: Block 4 - 3 - 2 - 1 - 6

Row #6: Block 5 - 1 - 6

Row #7: Block 7

2. Sew neighboring blocks together to create each row. Press.
3. Sew rows together to create the main design. Press.



## BORDER ASSEMBLY:

1. To achieve the necessary length for each border, place [2] Blender Navy 4-1/4" x WOF strips, RST. Sew seam across the short end. Press.
2. Make [2] side borders 4-1/4" x 68"  
Make [2] top/bottom borders 4-1/4" x 76"
3. Measure length. Add an additional strip if necessary to achieve desired length.
4. Trim excess fabric.
5. To add borders, first, sew border to right and left sides of the quilt top.
6. Then, sew on borders to the top and bottom of quilt top.



## FINISHING:

1. Layer quilt top with batting and backing.
2. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind.
4. Label and Enjoy!
